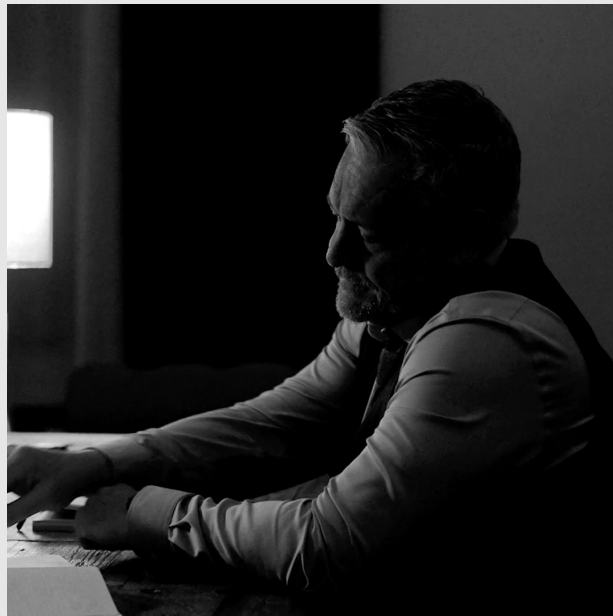
A psychiatrist's office, a late-night encounter, and the weight of concealed truths.
